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Klonopin® (Clonazepam) 3 mg Strength — Weight Chart

Note: 3 mg is included as a mathematical tablet-equivalent column at the requester's direction. The FDA-labeled Klonopin tablet strengths are 0.5 mg, 1 mg, and 2 mg; a 3 mg tablet should not be assumed to be an available Klonopin tablet strength.
